JIM AND CAROL HENRICHS SCHOLARSHIP

The Henrichs family has endowed a scholarship to Father McGivney Catholic High School. The scholarship will be awarded annually to an eighth grade graduate to pursue and education at Father McGivney Catholic High School. The recipient must exhibit sufficient academic progress with at least a 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale, must provide an essay stating why he/she would like to continue their Catholic education, and must demonstrate financial need by applying and qualifying for financial assistance through FACTS. The scholarship amount will be set at \$2000.00 for this year. Students from St. Paul's parish in Highland are given first preference. If no student meeting this criteria applies, students residing in the Highland Area Community Foundation service area (the Highland Community School District (CUSD #5) and Marine and St. Jacob Townships) shall be considered next. If no applicant meets either of these criteria, the scholarship funds shall be held for the following school year. This is a one-time award and is to specifically be used toward the parental contribution portion of tuition. Applications must be received by the Student Services Office at Father McGivney by March 31 of each school year.

Scholarship applicants must:

- Demonstrate financial need by completing the FACTs Grant & Aid Online Assessment at <https://online.factsmgt.com/signin/4JLSN>
- Submit a current grade report showing grades equivalent to a 2.5 GPA
- Submit an essay on why you want to continue with a Catholic education
- Provide this completed form with the essay, to Father McGivney Catholic High School, attn: Bobbie Madura
